Arrow Technical Services Ltd is a high quality product development company specialising in developing new electronic technologies.

From a background in designing specialised controllers for aerospace applications, the company have developed a range of in-house technologies which greatly simplifies and speeds up the process of turning a good idea into a fully working, field proven, market-ready production design and now supply products and systems into automotive, industrial, scientific and consumer electronic markets for clients around the world.

Creativesheffield started to work with Arrow Technical in 2005 when it was identified that, due to rapid company growth, the company required larger premises that reflected the high tech activities of the business and offered the opportunity to co-locate and work in collaboration with similarly forward-thinking, innovative organisations.

Creativesheffield aided the company in identifying their property requirements, viewing a range of accommodation options. Creativesheffield also brokered introductions to grant support consultants and Business Link in order to identify sources of funding for the company expansion and provided a dedicated, professional HR Business Consultant (free of charge) in order to recruit a Business Development Manager and Electronic Engineer.

Arrow Technical relocated to the AMP Technology Centre on the Advanced Manufacturing Park (AMP) in April 2007.

Following this relocation, Creativesheffield continued to keep Arrow Technical informed of industry events and new funding opportunities, facilitated networking opportunities for the company to meet with other advanced manufacturing and electronics organisations, and continued to provide property, funding and recruitment advice.

In 2009, Arrow Technical were successful in being awarded a £90,000 Grant for Business Investment (GBI) by Yorkshire Forward and relocated to a bespoke 3,000 sq ft unit at Evolution @ the AMP in January 2010. This relocation has created a further 8 new jobs.
